LAMAR COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Lamar County Department of Health offers clinical care to the public, providing services including vaccinations, STD testing, family planning services and breast and cervical cancer screening. The Department of Health also coordinates with outside agencies to provide qualifying patients with WIC, home health services, occupational therapy, speech and language pathology, physical therapy, and medical social services. Copies of birth, death, marriage, and divorce certificates can also be obtained at this Department of Health.

Interpretive services are available.

This clinic accepts Medicare, Medicaid, VA and Tricare, Blue Cross Blue Shield, and other private insurance. This is a healthcare center funded by the federal government. This means even if you have no insurance, you can be covered.
