MARION COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Marion County Department of Health offers clinical care to the public, providing services including vaccinations, STD testing, family planning services and breast and cervical cancer screening. The Department of Health also coordinates with outside agencies to provide qualifying patients with WIC, home health services, occupational therapy, speech and language pathology, physical therapy, and medical social services. Copies of birth, death, marriage, and divorce certificates can also be obtained at this Department of Health.

Interpretive services are available.

Walk-ins & appointments are welcome.

This clinic accepts Medicare, Medicaid, VA and Tricare, Blue Cross Blue Shield, and other private insurance. This is a healthcare center funded by the federal government. This means even if you have no insurance, you can be covered.

Northwest Alabama Mental Health Center is a facility that helps families with mental health issues. They help facilitate Adult Case Management, Adult Crisis Stabilization Unit, Adult Intensive Day Treatment, Adult Outpatient, Adult Partial Hospitalization Program, Adult Rehabilitative Day Program, Adult Residential Services, Child/Adolescent Case Management, Child/Adolescent Day Treatment, Child/Adolescent Outpatient, Consultation & Education. They also handle DMHF - Outpatient Commitment, Emergency Services and Juvenile Court Liaison.

They also have a 24-hour Emergency Services, Crisis Intervention, Case Management, Family Support and Education, Pre-hospital Screenings, Psychiatric Evaluation and Medication Assessment, Basic Living Skills, and Day Programs.
