## **ACCORDIA HEALTH MOBILE COUNTY — CHILDREN'S CARE**

## **COMMUNITY SERVICES FOR VISION REHABILITATION**

Community Services for Vision Rehabilitation (CSVr) is a nonprofit medical clinic which provides evaluation and rehabilitation to those with vision loss. It features initial evaluation by an MD or OD, training by Occupational Therapist and strong glasses, magnifiers, and devices. CSVr will see patients of any age, with any eye condition and with or without insurance. CSVr does not provide routine eye care, surgery, or prescription glasses.

Franklin Primary Health Center is a non-profit, federally qualified health center. They have 23 clinics in 6 counties (Mobile, Baldwin, Choctaw, Escambia, Monroe and Conecuh) in Alabama. The services provided by Franklin includes pediatrics, OB/GYN, family medicine, internal medicine, geriatrics, rheumatology, dentistry, optometry, physical therapy, nutrition services, wellness & fitness, social services, substance abuse prevention and treatment, HIV/AIDS services including case management, health education, pharmacy, laboratory, x-ray, and transportation services for the homeless.

This clinic accepts Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurance. Uninsured patients are welcome. The clinic uses a sliding scale payment model – the cost of your care is based upon your income and ability to pay.

Victory Health Partners is a 501(c)(3) non-profit healthcare organization established under the laws of the State of Alabama to provide a continuum of affordable quality care for the low-income uninsured population of the greater Mobile area.

Victory does not accept insurance or government funding but is funded by tax-deductible contributions from supporters.

The clinic provides general medical care, laboratory, X-rays, EKGs, and counseling, Dental Clinic, Medication Dispensary program, Incontinence Clinic, Pulmonary Clinic, Hepatitis C treatment, Wound Care Clinic, Women's Wellness Exams, MRIs, Minor Surgeries, Urology Clinic, Neurology Clinic, Diabetes Education Program and Respiratory/Sleep Apnea Clinic, Eye clinic, Neurology Clinic, mammograms and PAP smears for its female patients and free colon screenings for those who qualify through a free state program.

The Dental Clinic offers routine cleanings, X-rays, and treatment. This is the only clinic at Victory that will serve Medicare and Medicaid patients because not all Medicaid and Medicare patients receive dental services.
